



## **Travel Checklist**

Things to consider Sign into MyChart
Medical Alert ID
Proof of prescription or pharmacy labels
Travel clinic for immunizations
Travel insurance
Check with your airline about new security regulations
Insulated container to cool insulin, ie. Frio kit
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First aid kit with pain relievers, antibiotic cream, bandages, gauze, tape,
thermometer, re-hydration source
Medication for vomiting and diarrhea
Madison Clinic Emergency Contact Form Completed
Madison Clinic Letter for TSA/Airline
Foreign language sheets explaining you have T1DM or need juice/sugar
"Essentials" in carry-on baggage
Two blood glucose meters, packed in separate bags, if possible
Extra meter batteries
Meter test strips
Lancets
Insulin- double the amount you think you will need/back up vial or pen
Syringes or Insulin pens and pen needles
Alcohol wipes
Ketone strips or Precision Extra meter with blood ketone strips
Glucagon emergency kit
Fast-acting carbohydrates to treat low blood glucose
Starchy carbohydrate sources for snacks
Emergency numbers
Pumper: In addition to many of the above
Written list of the pump settings
Instructions for switching back to injections and all necessary supplies above
Loaner pumpif desired contact pump company.
Pump batteries
IV Prep/Skin Prep/Alcohol
Tegaderm/IV 3000/Hypafix/tape
Infusion sets and insertion device (if needed)
Reservoirs
Continuous Glucose Monitor (CGM's)
Sensors and insertion device (if needed)
Transmitter
Receiver (Dexcom)
